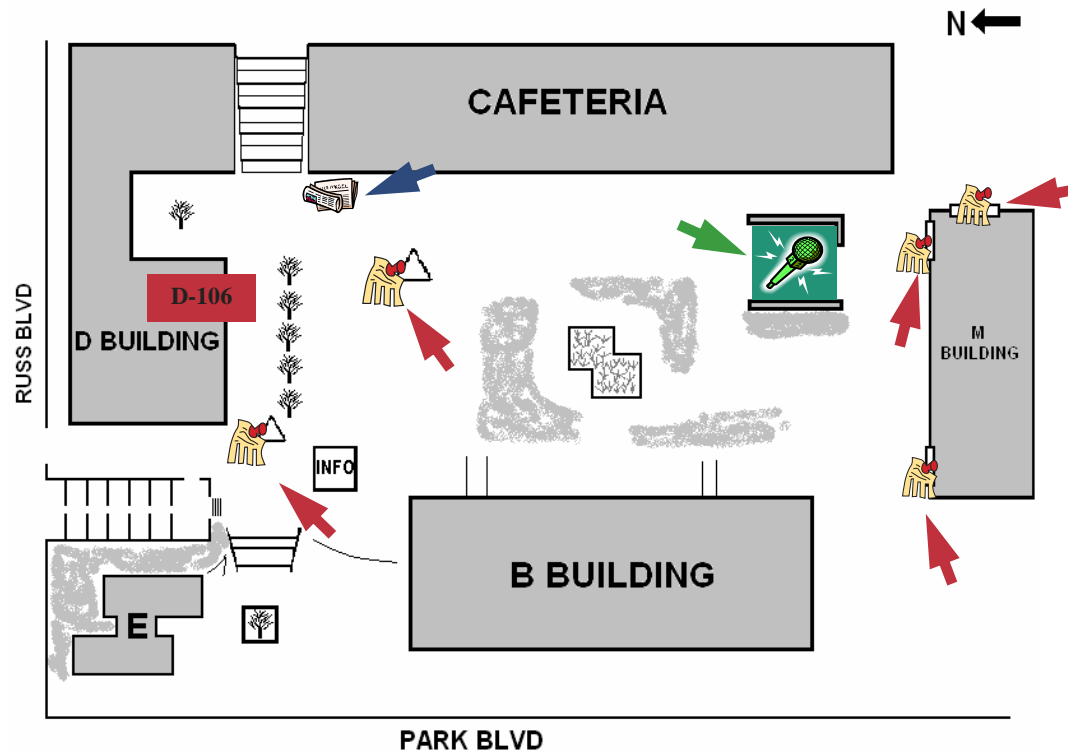

Guidelines for Free Speech Activities

Based on San Diego Community College District's Policy 3925
Approved March 9, 2004





San Diego City College is a non-public forum, except for a designated free speech area. A free speech area has been designated on campus to maximize the opportunity for free discussion and expression, while minimizing the potential for disruption of classroom and college activities and interference with the ability of the students to obtain an education. The free speech area is available during the normal hours of college operation.

Designated Free Speech Area:

- City College has a designated area for a variety of free speech activities, e.g., speeches/presentations, rallies, distribution of literature, posting, and voter registration. The map on the back of this brochure identifies the designated free speech area. If you have any questions or need clarification, contact the Office of Student Affairs.
- Restrictions shall not be placed on subject matter, topics or viewpoints expressed in the designated free speech area.
- The designated free speech area is listed on the map.



- All visitors are encouraged to check in with the Office of Student Affairs to advise College officials of the presence of visitors on campus.

Posting:

- Kiosks and/or bulletin boards located in the designated free speech area are designated for general posting. See locations on the map.
- Posting of materials by other than college affiliated groups, will not be permitted except in the designated free speech area.
- Material content must convey lawful activities and not be misleading.
- Commercial literature must have the organization/institution affiliation, along with address and telephone number clearly stated.
- Materials posted on designated “free speech” bulletin boards or kiosks will be removed weekly.
- City College does not endorse, approve, authorize, sponsor or regulate any commercial business, commodity, service or entertainment posted or distributed on campus.



Distribution of Literature:

- Petitions, circulars, leaflets, newspapers and printed materials may be distributed in the designated free speech area.
- No person or organization distributing materials in the free speech area shall coerce any person into accepting any material.

- Newspapers, leaflets, and other printed materials may be left for distribution in designated areas only. Check with the Office of Student Affairs or check the map.

- Litter, resulting from discarded materials in and around the free speech area must be retrieved by persons distributing the material prior to departure.

Support Services:

- Tables, chairs, sound system and other support materials may be provided by the college on a limited basis for registered City College student organizations.
- Parking permits will not be provided.
- Appropriate forms must be submitted one week prior to the planned activity.

Vending on Campus:

- Vending activities are limited to college sponsored and approved special events related to the educational mission of the college and must have prior approval by the Dean of Student Affairs.

Voter Registration:

- Voter registration in other than the free speech area must be scheduled in advance (48 hours recommended).
- Contact the Office of Student Affairs to schedule a time.
