### **PARKING FINE INCREASES EFFECTIVE AUGUST 24**

In their July 9<sup>th</sup> meeting, the SDCCD Board of Trustees approved a slate of increases in SDCCD parking citation fine amounts that take effect August 24. This impacts students and District employees.

The standard \$25 parking fine is being increased to \$35. The fine for failure to display a valid staff/faculty parking permit is going from \$25 to \$50 and fines for illegally parking in disabled persons spaces are being raised from \$340 to \$440.

Parking fine increases were necessary to cover an increase in the portion of parking fines that must be forwarded to the County of San Diego and State of California each month. Effective January 1, 2009, Senate Bill 1407 increased the amount of each paid citation that must be forwarded to the County.

The state does not (help fund) supplement public college parking programs and SDCCD, like most other colleges in California, relies upon revenue from parking permits and fines to provide parking services to our campuses.

The \$10 increase in most fines was made to cover the increase imposed by SB1407. The fine for parking in staff/faculty parking without a valid permit and for parking in parking reserved for owners of a valid disabled parking placard were increased to provide more of a “dis-incentive” for parking illegally in these spaces.
